TERRORISM WARNINGS

SUSPICIOUS TERRORIST ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:

ATTACK IMMINENT

- ⇒ Tunnel Vision
- ⇒ Unresponsive to Verbal Commands
- ⇒ Profuse Sweating
- ⇒ Nervousness
- ⇒ Repeatedly checks self
- ⇒ Hands concealed in pockets, luggage bags, etc.
- ⇒ Carrying or is adjacent to a large object
- ⇒ Irregular glances from side to side
- ⇒ Loose inappropriate clothing
- ⇒ Pale from recent shaving
- ⇒ Inappropriate or lack of eye contact

CONSISTENTLY

- ⇒ Supply Acquisition
 - Purchase or Stealing Weapons
 - Large Quantities of Similar Electronics
 - Purchase or Theft of Explosives

USUALLY

- ⇒ Intel Gathering
 - Taking Pictures
 - Taking Notes
- ⇒ Supply Staging
 - Abandoned Vehicles
 - Concealed Packages
- ⇒ Odd Activity or Indicators
 - Chemical Odors and/or Stains
- ⇒ Criminal Activity
 - Petty Theft
 - Drug Related

RARELY

- ⇒ Attack Rehearsal
 - Frequently Visiting Same Site
 - Following Exact Pattern Repeatedly
- ⇒ Unusual Clothing
 - Bulky/Unseasonable
 - Mainly Green/Yellow¹
- ⇒ Significant Dates
 - Event Anniversaries
 - Holy Days

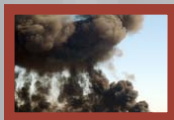
¹Green and yellow are important colors in Islam and are favorites among radicals and extremists.

SOMETIMES

- ⇒ False Document
 - Fake ID
 - Fake License Plate
- ⇒ Extremist Writings
 - Pamphlets, Booklets, Flyers
 - Graffiti/Tagging
- ⇒ Avoiding Security
 - Purposefully Avoiding Guards/Cameras
- ⇒ Large Bill Usage
 - \$100 for Small Purchases
 - Using Cash for Large Purchases

2. ARMED ATTACK



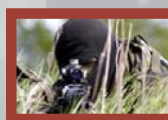

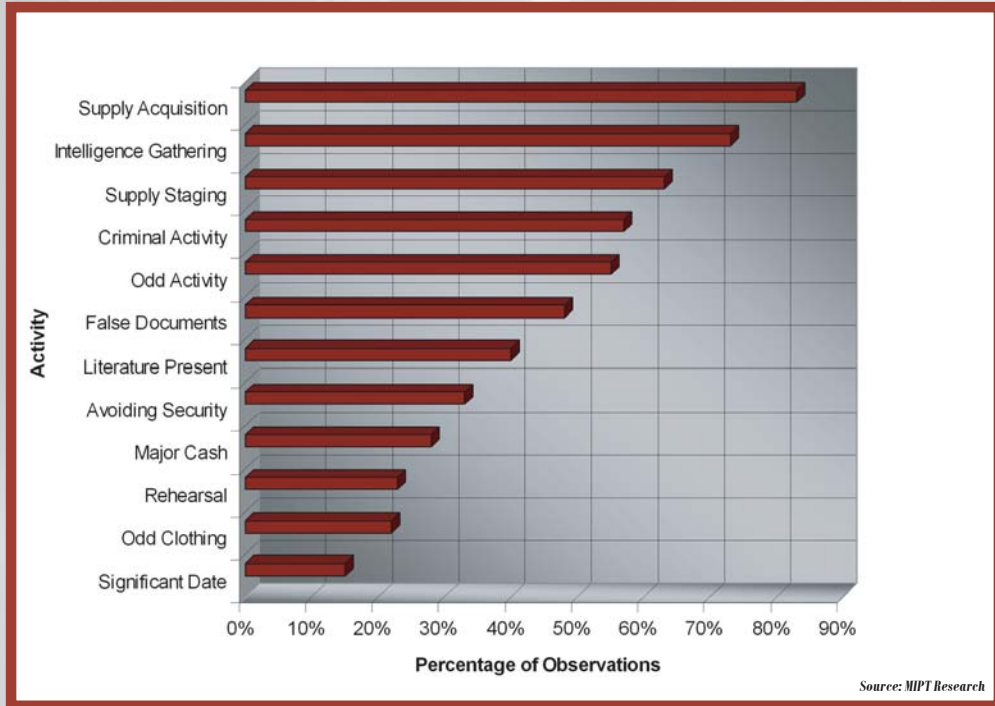
